health and disability workers have completed **Engaging Pasifika** cultural competency training



Between July 2018 and June 2019

789 health workers completed **Engaging Pasifika** training at **27** workshops across the country.



(0=not at all confident, 5=extremely confident)




Participants' knowledge and confidence to effectively engage with Pasifika peoples increases following eLearning, and increases even further following the face-to-face workshops, including the application of skills.

99% of people say that the Engaging Pasifika training is excellent


98% of people say that the Engaging Pasifika training equipped them with new skills that they would apply to their professional practice
