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Following completion of EP online...

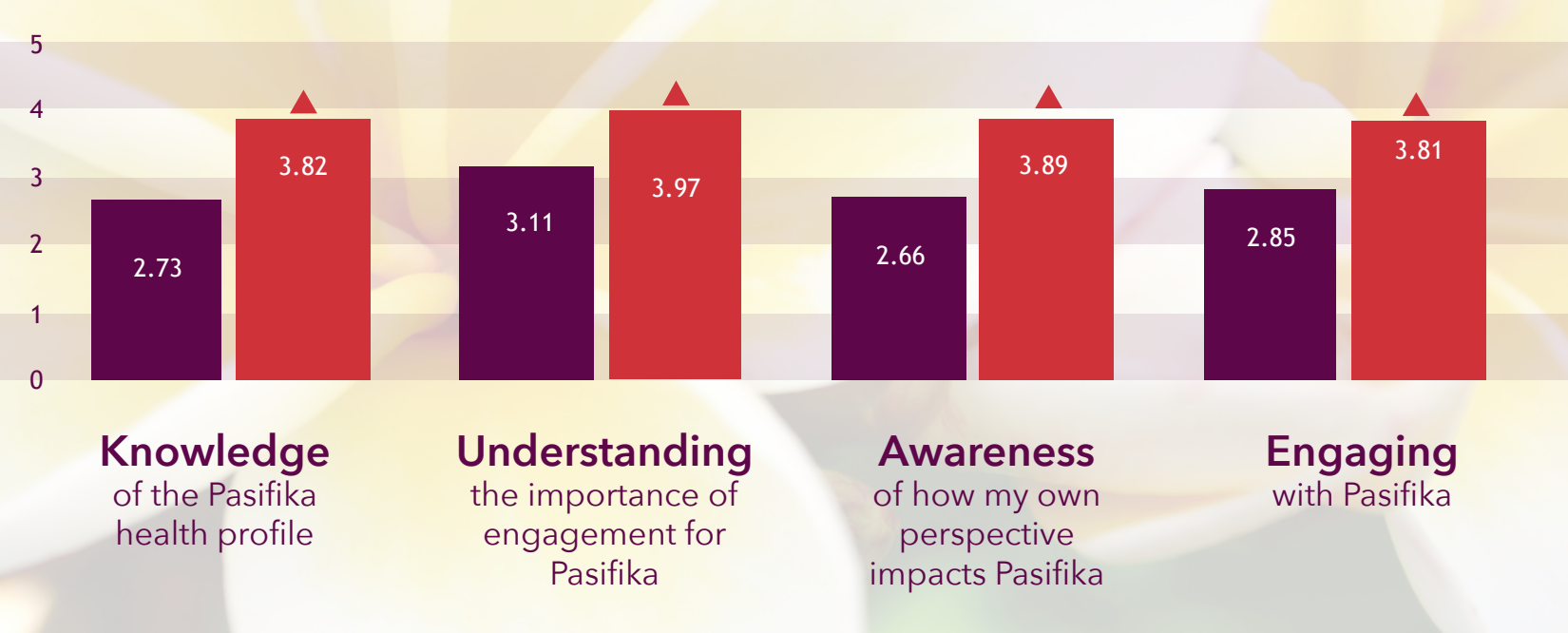
disability workshop participants show an overall average increase in confidence when engaging with Pasifika people

(0=not at all confident, 5=extremely confident)

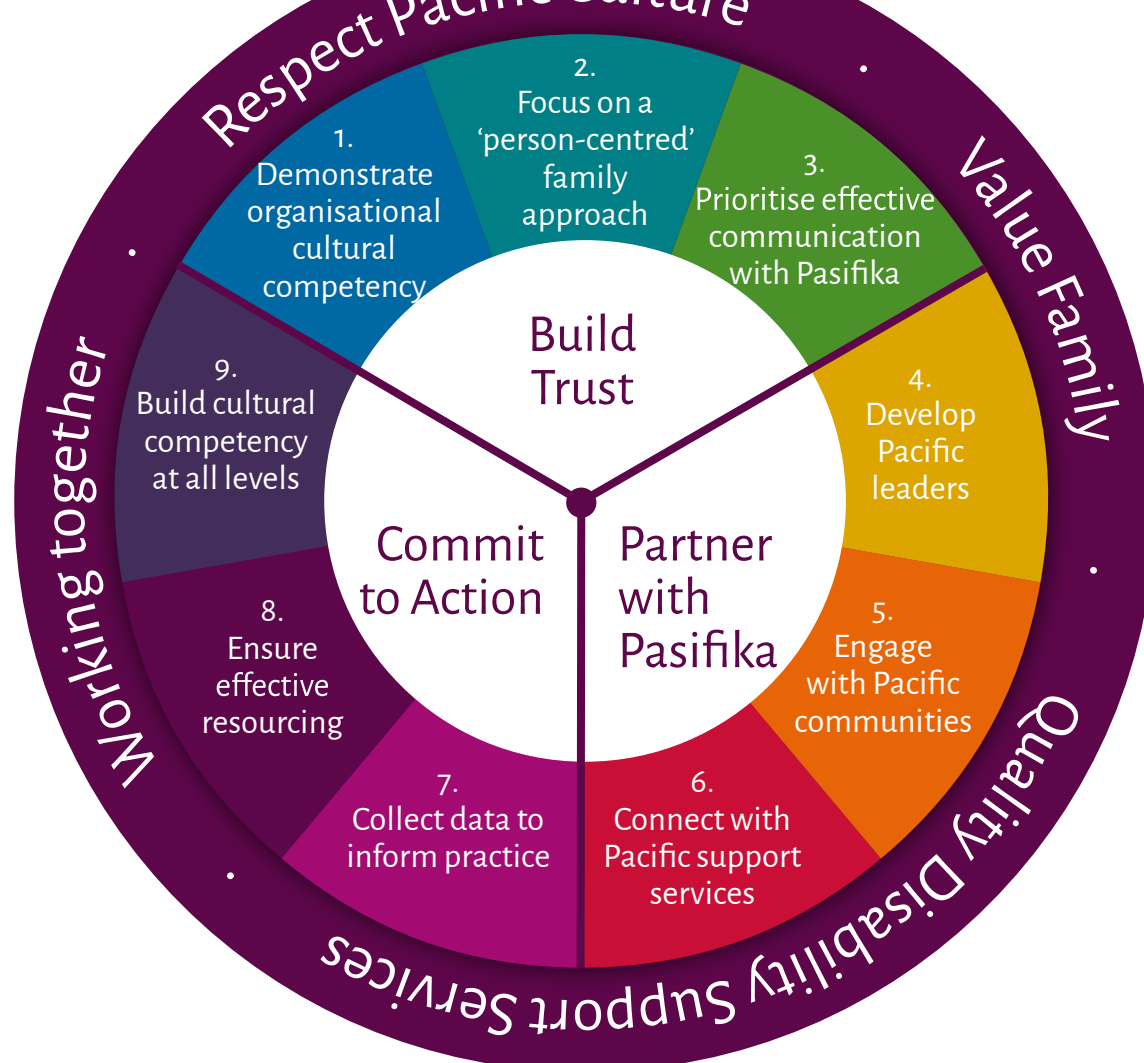
Before EP Online
